DUI Checkpoint Planned For Elko, White Pine, Humboldt and Lander County

Labor Day Weekend is just around the corner, and northeastern Nevada Law Enforcement will be "JOINING FORCES" and beefing up patrols around the state.

Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over is a national campaign that cracks down on drunk driving. If you plan on consuming alcohol, plan on not driving. The consequences??? You go to jail, car will be towed, license suspended, and you will pay fines (1st offense DUI is at least \$750).

The Nevada Highway Patrol, along with Sheriffs Departments from Elko, White Pine, Humboldt and Lander County, and the Police Departments from Elko, Winnemucca, and West Wendover will be working together, *Joining Forces*, to look for those impaired drivers over the Labor Day weekend.

In 2010, the Nevada Highway Patrol—statewide-- arrested 3,792 drivers for DUI.
