Driver Dies and Two Injured in Vehicle Rollover

On Sunday, October 23rd, 2011, at approximately 10:08 pm, Nevada Highway Patrol responded to an accident on Interstate Summerlin Parkway west Of Buffalo Drive.

Preliminary Investigations reveal a white 2008 Toyota FJ Cruiser, driven by 19 year old Alexander Ross Lawrence of Las Vegas, was traveling eastbound on Summerlin Parkway. Alexander Ross Lawrence steered the vehicle to the left then abruptly back to the right losing control of the vehicle.

The vehicle rotated clockwise traveling off the right edge of the roadway where it overturned. Alexander Ross Lawrence, who was not wearing his seat belt, was ejected from the vehicle. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

The two male passengers, ages 17 and 18, also from Las Vegas, were transported to University Medical Center by ground with non life threatening injuries.
