Dyer Resident Killed in Single-Vehicle Rollover Accident Saturday in Esmeralda County

On Saturday morning, May 21, 2011, at approximately 10:46 am, troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a single-vehicle rollover crash on State Route 264 in Esmeralda County, approximately 1.5 miles north of the California Stateline.

The preliminary crash investigation details tell us that 69-year-old Diane M. Seidenverg of Dyer was traveling northbound on the two-lane highway where the posted speed limit is 55 miles per hour. For reasons unknown, she allowed the white 1997 Ford Explorer she was driving to veer toward the right edge of the roadway. She over-corrected her vehicle's steering to the left and then over-compensated the steering to the right once more. The vehicle skidded off the right edge of the roadway and rolled over several times. Ms. Seidenverg was not wearing a seat belt and was ejected from her vehicle and was pronounced deceased at the accident scene.
