Hawthorne Woman Arrested for Embezzling over \$62,000 from a Family Member

On April 8, 2011 the Mineral County Sheriff's Department arrested Anna Marie Black for an active arrest warrant. The arrest warrant was issued by the Hawthorne Township Justice Court. The warrant was obtained and the arrest was made following an investigation by the Nevada Department of Public Safety/Investigation Division.

According to the Affidavit, the suspect is alleged to have embezzled over \$62,000 from her Step-Grandfather during a two year period. The suspect had gained access to the victim's bank account while helping him write checks for his bills and balancing his checking account.

Black was booked into the Mineral County Jail in Hawthorne, Nevada. The warrant charged Black with two (2) counts of embezzlement committed against a person over 60 years of age or older, one (1) count of exploitation of the elderly, and ten (10) counts of grand larceny. Black's bail is set at \$205,000.00.
