Incline Resident Injured in Vehicle Rollover on State Route 207

On May 5, 2011, at approximately 9:14 p.m. Nevada Highway Patrol was dispatched to an injury crash on State Route 207 approximately 3 miles west of State Route 206 (Foothill Road).

The crash investigation details so far indicate that a white Jeep Wrangler was traveling eastbound on SR 207 driven by Miguel Vargas Mejia a 61-year-old Incline resident. The Jeep Wrangler drifted off the roadway striking a boulder and overturning. Mr. Mejia was airlifted by Care Flight and flown to Reno at Renown Regional Medical Center with non life threatening injuries. There was a male passenger that was ground transported to the Carson Valley Medical Center for precautionary measures.

SR 207 was closed temporarily until the accident scene was investigated. Alcohol is suspected as a contributing factor to the accident.
