Joining Forces DUI Enforcement in Las Vegas Oct. 25th-Nov. 7th

The Nevada Department of Public Safety / Highway Patrol Division will begin increased DUI patrols on Tuesday October 25th.

Over the next 2 weeks, Troopers from the DPS/NHP will “JOIN FORCES” with law enforcement agencies throughout Clark County. The goal is to identify impaired drivers and get them off the road before they crash, killing themselves or someone else.

With grant money from the Nevada Office of Traffic Safety, NHP will have over 100 hours of overtime available to conduct saturation patrols and DUI checkpoints. Troopers will conduct a high frequency of traffic stops for any and all hazardous moving or mechanical violations.
