Minnesota Man Killed in Motorcycle Accident on Rural Nevada Highway

On Tuesday, June 21, at approximately 5:45pm, Mr. David Krebs, age, 59, from Sartell, Minnesota, was riding a 2009 Kawasaki motorcycle eastbound on US 50, 13 miles west of Austin, Nevada. For unknown reasons, Mr. Krebs allowed his motorcycle to cross the center line and westbound travel lane into the north dirt shoulder. The motorcycle continued to travel off the dirt shoulder and strike a large sagebrush.

The motorcycle overturned, and Mr. Krebs was thrown from the motorcycle. The motorcycle landed on top of Mr. Krebs. Mr. Krebs sustained fatal injuries at the scene, he was wearing a helmet.

Preliminary investigation indicates driver inattention may be a contributing factor in the accident.
