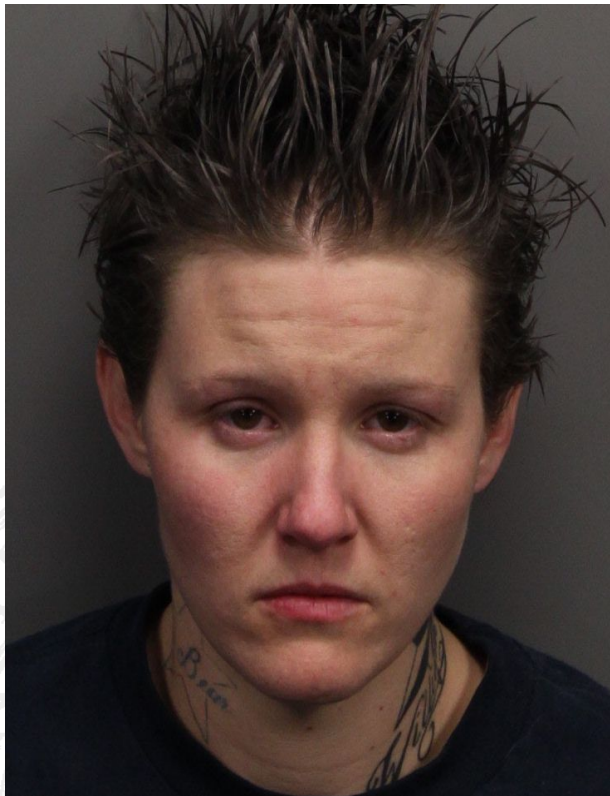
Passenger Arrested for Felony No-Bail Warrant and Nine Misdemeanor Warrants

On Thursday, December 1, 2011 at approximately 2:05 pm, a trooper with the Nevada Highway Patrol conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle displaying fictitious registration on US 395 near Oddie Blvd.

The vehicle stopped was a gray Mazda 4-door sedan displaying Nevada license plates belonging to a Jeep. The driver received a citation for the registration violation and the vehicle was towed away and impounded until proper registration could be produced. The right front passenger riding in the Mazda sedan, identified as 26-year-old Patricia M. Pinna of Sun Valley, told the trooper she did not have any identification with her when asked. When she exited the vehicle, her Nevada identification card was observed on the floor of the car.

A records check was requested and the trooper was advised that Ms. Pinna had a felony no-bail warrant from the Clark County District Court charging her with possession of a stolen vehicle. Additionally, there were nine non-extraditable misdemeanor warrants for her arrest stemming from previous offenses in the Las Vegas area.

She was placed under arrest and taken to the Washoe County Detention Facility and booked on the no-bail felony warrant. Once extradited to Clark County for the felony warrant, she will be held on the misdemeanor warrants until they are cleared.
