Red Chevy Camero Collides with White Tour Bus on Interstate 15 North of Moapa

Wednesday June 23rd, 2011 at approximately 0705hrs (7:05am) a two vehicle collision involving a tour bus with 41 passengers and a passenger vehicle with a single occupant was involved in a collision early Wednesday morning.

Preliminary investigations indicates a white tour bus traveling north on Interstate 15 near mile marker 97 was attempting to make a u-turn from the #1 northbound travel lane across the center dirt median. The tour bus came to a stop in the #1 lane. A red Camero driven by 41 year old Tracy Lynn Rodgers collided with the rear of the tour bus.

41 year old Tracy Lynn Rodgers sustained serious injuries as a result of the crash and was air lifted by Life Flight from the scene to University Medical Trauma Center in Las Vegas. Eight passengers on the bus claimed minor injuries and refused medical treatment. The driver of the tour bus 46 year old Jianchun Guo was uninjured. The investigation to determine the cause of the collision is still ongoing.
