Retired NFL Quarterback Jim McMahon Injured in Car Crash

On Monday, July 18, 2011 at approximately 1:59pm, retired NFL quarterback Jim McMahon was being driven to the Reno Tahoe Airport by a Bell Limousine. The limousine was driven by 40 year old Robert McCoy of Sparks, Nevada. The limousine was northbound on US 395 in Pleasant Valley (approximately 11 miles south of the airport). The limousine drifted out of the lane and traveled off the highway through a barbed wire fence. The limousine fell approximately 6-10 feet to a grass pasture striking a culvert and a drainage ditch. The limousine came to rest on its wheels but sustained major front end damage.

The passengers in the limousine were 51 year old Jim McMahon, and 46 year old Lori Navon, both from Scottsdale, Arizona.

Both Mr. McMahon and Ms. Navon were transported to Renown Medical center with non life-threatening injuries. The driver, Mr. McCoy was also transported to Renown Medical Center with non life-threatening injuries.

The crash is still under investigation. Alcohol was not believed to be a factor in the crash.
