Tuesday June 7, 2011 Department of Public Safety Nevada Highway Patrol *Northern Command* conducted a 24 hour period of commercial vehicle inspections.

The purpose of the nation wide inspection is to educate commercial vehicle drivers and others about the importance of safe driving, buckling up, and maintaining safe vehicles. Lives are being saved because roadside inspections conducted by Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA)-certified inspectors take place every day throughout North America. The inspections conducted during the 72 hour Roadcheck 2010 event resulted in 15 lives saved and 276 injuries avoided.
