Speed on Wet Roadway Takes the Life of Las Vegas Man

On December 18, 2011 at approximately 8:34 p.m., Nevada Highway Patrol was dispatched to an accident on Interstate 215 east in Las Vegas.

The preliminary accident investigation details indicate a gold and white Ford Explorer was traveling on the I-215 eastbound to I-15 southbound transition ramp in the #2 travel lane. The driver of the Ford Explorer was traveling too fast for conditions and lost traction on the wet roadway. The Ford Explorer ultimately overturned on the left rock shoulder of the transition ramp.

The right front passenger, Margaret M. Crinigan of Las Vegas, NV was transported to UMC where she was pronounced dead on December 18, 2011, at 1405 hours by Dr. Browder.
