Driver of Motorcycle Killed After Colliding with Chevy Tahoe

On Monday, April 9, 2012, at approximately 9:29am, Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to an accident involved a vehicle and motorcycle on northbound US-95.

The preliminary crash investigation details indicate a purple 2002 Harley Davidson motorcycle was traveling northbound on US-93 north of mile marker 67 Clark. A silver 2011 Chevrolet Tahoe was traveling northbound on US-93, ahead of the motorcycle. The Chevrolet Tahoe began to make a left turn onto a dirt road. The motorcycle attempted to pass the Tahoe on the left as the Tahoe began to make the left turn. The motorcycle struck the right rear portion of the Tahoe and the rider and motorcycle went down.

The 64 year old, Barry Craig Isom of Panaca, NV suffered fatal injuries as a result of the crash and was pronounced dead at the scene at 12:55 pm on 04-09-12 by Clark County Coroner investigator Kristen Peters.

The three occupants of the Tahoe were uninjured in the collision.
