Las Vegas Man Killed in Single Vehicle Collision

On April 10, 2012, at approximately 4:34pm, Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a single vehicle collision on southbound US 95 south of State Route 147.

The preliminary crash investigation details indicate a black 2011 Hyundai Sonata was traveling southbound on US-95 in the #2 travel lane, south of Lake Mead Boulevard. The #1 travel lane (HOV lane) was closed for construction. The Hyundai traveled into closed construction area, crossed the #1 travel lane and entered the east paved shoulder. The left side of the Hyundai struck the concrete median wall. The Hyundai continued traveling southbound in the east paved shoulder and struck the concrete median wall multiple times. The front of the Hyundai struck a construction sign in the east paved shoulder. The Hyundai also struck multiple construction barrels while traveling southbound in the east paved shoulder. The Hyundai then traveled southwesterly from the east paved shoulder and crossed all southbound travel lanes. The right side of the Hyundai struck the west guardrail.

The driver, 65 year old Frank Leo Drozd of Las Vegas, NV was pronounced dead at University Medical Center (UMC) at 4:59pm on April 10, 2012, by Doctor Browder.
