### **Multi-State “Joining Forces” DUI Enforcement Campaign June 29<sup>th</sup> – July 8th**

This year, our 4<sup>th</sup> of July “Joining Forces” DUI campaign will involve other states and counties from Utah and Idaho.

The Nevada Highway Patrol, Utah Highway Patrol, and Idaho State Police (seen in picture above) will be working together June 29 & 30 to look for impaired drivers and reduce accidents in our respective states. “Our campaign this year is unique. Utah and Idaho are working the same Joining Forces weekend as we are”, says Trooper Jim Stewart with the NHP. “Not only that, but other county sheriff’s departments and city PD’s in all three states are also participating!”

The Nevada Joining Forces program has been a huge success for years. Just remember that if you cross that state line, the campaign is still the same in other states.

The Nevada Joining Forces campaigns are funded through grants from the DPS Office of Traffic Safety. The grants provide funds for law enforcement to work extra hours to reduce accidents and get impaired drivers off the road.
