Two Car Collision Rollover on US 95 Kills Henderson Man

On Sunday, January 8, 2012, at approximately 9:42 pm, troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to an accident on northbound US 95.

The preliminary crash investigation details reveal a black 2008 Volkswagen 2 door/hatchback was traveling northbound on US-95, in the left travel lane, approaching Wagon Wheel Drive.

At the same time a white 2011 Toyota Yaris 4 door was traveling northbound on US-95, in the center travel lane. The Volkswagen was to the left of the Toyota.

The Volkswagen traveled partially onto the left dirt/gravel median, rotating clockwise and then back onto the roadway into the path of the Toyota. The right side of the Volkswagen struck the left front of the Toyota.

Both vehicles traveled onto the right dirt/gravel shoulder where they overturned.

The 47 year old driver of the Volkswagen who was from Henderson, NV, was not wearing a seat belt and was ejected. He was transported to Sunrise Hospital.

The male passenger of the Volkswagen and the male driver and two male and one female passengers of the Toyota were transported to St. Rose Sienna hospital with non life threatening injuries.

On Monday, January 9, 2012 the driver of the Volkswagen succumbed to his injuries sustained in the crash. The drivers' next of kin has not been notified.
