Elko Joining Force's DUI Saturation Patrol Super Bowl Weekend

In an effort to reduce alcohol-related crashes during the Super Bowl weekend, Northeastern Nevada Law Enforcement are cracking down on DUI's this superbowl weekend. Agencies include the Nevada Highway Patrol, Winnemucca & West Wendover Police Departments, and Sheriffs Departments from White Pine, Lander, and Elko County. "We are 'Joining Forces' to look for impaired drivers" says Trooper Jim Stewart with NHP.

If you are arrested for DUI, you can loose your license for 90 days, your vehicle may get towed, expect fines up to \$1,000, and jail time. It's not worth the risk. On Superbowl Sunday, get a designated driver!!!
