Mercury Grand Marquis Strikes Barrier Killing Driver

On Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at approximately 12:54 a.m., troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to an accident on Interstate 215 at Warm Springs Road.

The preliminary crash investigation details reveal a silver 1999 Mercury Grand Marquis was traveling on the IR-215 Eastbound/Warm Springs Road exit ramp approaching the intersection of Warm Springs Road. The Mercury entered the intersection on a red traffic signal and continued through where its front struck the barrier wall located on the south side of Warm Springs Road.

The driver, a 28 year old male from Las Vegas, NV, who was not wearing a seat belt, was pronounced dead on scene.
