Senior NHP Trooper Michael “Sean” Giurlani to Receive Badge #1

Nevada Highway Patrol Trooper Michael “Sean” Giurlani will be receiving badge number one on Monday, November 4th, identifying him as the senior trooper in the Silver State. This tradition was implemented many years ago where the trooper with the highest seniority is presented the lowest numbered badge following the retirement of the previous longest tenured trooper. Trooper Lori McGrath, who had been wearing this single-digit badge, recently retired earlier this month and the senior leadership of NHP will be recognizing Trooper Giurlani at his pinning ceremony on Monday afternoon.

Trooper Giurlani currently works in the Carson City area and has been a trooper for over 25 years. He started his law enforcement career in 1988 and served in Las Vegas after graduating from the NHP academy. He transferred to northern Nevada several years later and has worked several assignments in the Reno and Carson City areas to include the traffic and commercial motor vehicle enforcement sections, and a short tour with the background investigations unit. Trooper Giurlani has also been recognized with several awards during his tenure as a state trooper. Those accolades include the gold medal of valor, silver medal of valor, lifesaving medal, and he was also honored as NHP Trooper of the Year in 2007.
