#### **Joining Forces Pedestrian Enforcement Results for August 17 - 28, 2015**

With the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year, Nevada Highway Patrol Joined Forces with both Reno and Sparks Police departments and Washoe County Sheriff's Office to remind people the importance of pedestrian safety on all Northern Nevada roads.

This event was scheduled in conjunction with the opening of the new academic year and focused on school zones and heavily used pedestrian roadways and crossings in the local area. The Event focused on both vehicles and pedestrians legal use of the crosswalks and was utilized as a reminder to focus on not only motorist, but all people using the roads as more people will be taking to the streets with the school year underway.
