#### **Please Remember that Seatbelts Save Lives Click It or Ticket Campaign**

I forgot to put it on. I'm not driving very far. I don't want to get trapped underwater. You hear it all the time, reasons why vehicle occupants do not put on a seatbelt. Since 2010, vehicle fatalities where occupants were not wearing a seatbelt have consistently been in the 40 percent range with last year topping 50. Meaning over half of the individuals who died in vehicle collisions, were not wearing a seatbelt. To combat this rise, the Nevada Highway Patrol, along with all Southern Nevada law enforcement agencies will be Joining Forces with Click It or Ticket. And with the holidays upon us, there is never a more important time to remind vehicle occupants to buckle up.
