SANDOVAL TO HOST NEVADA DROUGHT SUMMIT

On April 8, 2015, Governor Brian Sandoval signed Executive Order 2015-03 which established the Nevada Drought Forum. The Forum was charged with the task to convene a multi-day stakeholder Drought Summit in September of 2015. The Forum consists of members of local water municipalities, state government, higher education, and climate experts. As part of the Summit, the Forum has also requested that affected industries, communities and local and federal partners join in the conversation.
