## Head On Crash on Sun Valley Blvd Sends Two to Local Area Hospitals

On Thursday, March 17, 2016 at approximately 6:23 a.m., Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a report of an injury accident blocking travel lanes on Sun Valley Boulevard just north of 2nd Avenue.

Preliminary crash investigation details indicate that a white Chevrolet pickup driven by 60 year old Terry Belvin of Reno Nevada was traveling southbound on Sun Valley Blvd when he allowed the truck to drift to the left, crossing the centerline and into the northbound fast lane. Northbound on Sun Valley Blvd in the fast lane was a black Audi driven by 21 year old Sun Valley resident Hector Flores-Hermosillo. In the rear of the Audi was a child, secured in a child safety seat under the age of one year old. With its front, the pickup struck the Audi head on. The pickup pushed the Audi south approximately 10 feet and both vehicles came to rest in the northbound travel lanes.

Belvin and his female passenger Tanisha Conley, were transported to a local area hospital with minor injuries. Flores-Hermosillo sustained substantial but non-life-threatening injuries and was also transported to a local area hospital for treatment. The infant was reported on scene as having no injuries.

Both northbound lanes of Sun Valley Blvd just north of 2nd Avenue were blocked for several hours during the course of the investigation and for roadway cleanup. This area of Sun Valley Blvd is two lanes in each direction and the speed limit is 35 mph. Impairment is under investigation in this crash.
