Pedestrian Struck and Killed on Fairview Drive and Gordon Street in Carson City

On Wednesday, March 2, 2016 at approximately 8:08 p.m., Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a single vehicle versus pedestrian collision that occurred on southbound Fairview Drive at the intersection with Gordon Street.

The preliminary crash investigation details indicate that a white 1996 GMC Safari van driven by 82 year old Carson City resident Lyman Andrews was traveling southbound on Fairview Drive approaching the intersection with Gordon Street in the slow lane.

46 year old Carson City resident Milissa Victorino was walking westbound in the marked crosswalk at Fairview Drive and Gordon Street. With its right front, the van struck Victorino. Victorino was transported by ground to a local area hospital by the Carson City Fire Department where she later succumbed to her injuries sustained during the crash.

Fairview Drive is a four lane road with two lanes in either direction and a center turn lane. The speed limit is 35 mph. Impairment is unknown at this time for either Andrews or Victorino as the investigation is in its preliminary stages.

CCSO made request for NHP to take primary role in the crash investigation.

Sergeant Dave Cox of the Nevada Highway Patrol's Multi-Disciplinary Investigation and Reconstruction Team (MIRT) is investigating this incident.
