Women Deceased in 4 Vehicle Crash on Flamingo and US95

On Wednesday, June 1, 2016 at approximately 10:46 p.m., Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a four vehicle crash that occurred on US95 and Flamingo.

The preliminary investigation details indicate that a blue 2014 Mazda CX-5 was eastbound on Flamingo approaching the controlled intersection of the US95/Flamingo northbound off ramp. A black Nissan Sentra and a red Toyota Camry were on the US95/Flamingo northbound off ramp approaching Flamingo. The Nissan was in the left lane and the Toyota in the right lane. As the two vehicles entered the intersection on a green light to go westbound on Flamingo the driver of the Mazda failed to stop for a red light and entered the same intersection striking the front of the Nissan. The Mazda continued east and struck the left side of the Toyota. The force of the impact redirected the Toyota to the northeast causing it to cross the centerline and strike the left rear of a silver Nissan Frontier who was stopped at a red light on westbound Flamingo.


The 71 year old female driver of the Toyota Camry was pronounced deceased on scene. The Clark County Corner will release the identity of the female once next of kin has been notified.

The driver of the Mazda was identified as 29 year old Denis Baldwin from Henderson, NV. He was transported to UMC and treated for minor injuries. He was then transported to the Clark County Detention Center and booked on one count of DUI Resulting in Death and Failure to Obey a Traffic Control Device.

This marks the Nevada Highway Patrol-Southern Command's 32nd fatal crash resulting in 35 fatalities for 2016.
