Arizona Resident Killed in Motorcycle Crash on US6 North of Tonopah

On Wednesday, September 13, 2017 at approximately 8:00AM, Nevada Highway Patrol Troopers were called to US6 near Nye County mile marker 19 (North of Tonopah) for a serious injury crash involving a motorcycle.

Preliminary investigation shows a maroon 2015 Canam Spider 3-wheeled motorcycle was traveling westbound on US6. For an unknown reason, the Canam drifted off the roadway to the right and struck a culvert sign. The rider (Kenneth D. Gunerius, an 81 year old Buckeye Arizona resident) was thrown from the motorcycle and suffered life threatening injuries. He was transported to a hospital in Las Vegas via ambulance and unfortunately succumbed to the injuries he sustained.
