Minivan Hits and Kills Juvenile Pedestrian

On Monday, March 13, 2017 at approximately 6:14 p.m., Nevada Highway Patrol Troopers were called to US 50A/16LY (near Pioneer Crossing) for a collision between a vehicle and a pedestrian.

The preliminary investigation indicates that a white 2013 Chrysler Town and Country Minivan was traveling westbound when the vehicle struck a juvenile pedestrian in the roadway.

The juvenile pedestrian was transported to a Reno hospital where he succumbed to the injuries he sustained from the collision. The cause and details of the collision are still under investigation. The Nevada Highway Patrol and Lyon County Sheriff's Office are working together on this investigation. It is unknown if alcohol or drugs are involved in this incident.
