Pedestrian Killed on Interstate 80 after Being Stuck by a Pickup

On Sunday, April 30, 2017 at approximately 9:30 p.m., Nevada Highway Patrol Troopers were dispatched to eastbound I80 near mile marker 66 in Churchill County (approximately 15 miles east of Fernley) for a fatal collision involving a pedestrian.

For an unknown reason, a pedestrian was in the left eastbound lane of Interstate 80. A white 2002 Dodge Dakota pickup was traveling eastbound in the left lane and struck the pedestrian with the left front of the vehicle.

The pedestrian (name withheld until next of kin is notified) died on scene as a result of the injuries sustained in the collision. The driver of the red Dodge Dakota did stay on scene and waited for Law Enforcement and cooperating fully during the investigation.
