Multi-Jurisdictional Effort Results in Ely State Prison Visitor Arrest

Ely, Nev. - The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) Office of the Inspector General and Nevada Department of Public Safety (DPS) Investigative Division (Eastern Nevada Narcotic Task Force) arrested a woman who tried to smuggle methamphetamine into Ely State Prison (ESP) while visiting with an inmate.

At approximately 9:00 AM, June 9, 2018, Aubriah Reynolds, 24, arrived at ESP for visiting. She was carrying 22 grams of methamphetamine which were seized by investigators. Aubriah Reynolds was taken into custody and booked into the White Pine County Sheriff's Public Safety Building for Trafficking a Controlled Substance, methamphetamine, one count of Furnishing Controlled Substance to a State Prisoner and one count of Transporting a Controlled Substance. Aubriah Reynolds is being held on a \$110,000.00 bail.

The Eastern Nevada Narcotic Task Force consists of the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Investigation Division, Nevada Department of Corrections, White Pine County Sheriff's Office, Eureka County Sheriff's Office, and the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office. The Task Force is funded in part by the Justice Assistant Grant.
