## Media Release

### **Three People Arrested by the Nevada DPS Investigation Division's Tri-NET Narcotic Task Force and the Reno Police Department's Street Enforcement Team Following a Narcotics Distribution Operation Investigation**

*Nevada* - On Wednesday, January 24, 2018, the Nevada Department of Public Safety Investigation Division's Tri-NET Narcotic Task Force and the Reno Police Department's Street Enforcement Team served a search warrant on a residence in the 3000 block of Gypsum Road in Reno following a two-month long investigation into a narcotics distribution operation. During service of the warrant, detectives recovered a significant quantity of illicit drugs including MDMA, Cocaine, LSD, Heroin, Ketamine, Psilocybin mushrooms, numerous illicit prescription pills to include Opioids, and marijuana and marijuana concentrates. Over \$9000 in US Currency was also recovered.

Also discovered during the initial search warrant was suspected child pornography. On Thursday, January 25, 2018, an additional search warrant on the Gypsum address was served and additional items were seized from the residence.

Three people were arrested and booked into the Washoe County Jail following service of the search warrant. Those individuals are:

Jacob Allen Myers age 26; charged with multiple counts of trafficking in a controlled substance and sales of a controlled substance; possession of controlled substance; maintaining a drug house; possession of a dangerous drug without a prescription; and conspiracy to violate the uniformed controlled substance act.

Prince Boachie-Darquah age 22; charged with multiple counts of trafficking in a controlled substance and sales of a controlled substance; possession of controlled substance; maintaining a drug house; possession of a dangerous drug without a prescription; and conspiracy to violate the uniformed controlled substance act.

Gina Gentry age 19; charged with multiple counts of possession of a controlled substance; and possession of a dangerous drug without a prescription.

The investigation is ongoing and may result in additional arrests.
