

The **DPS Training Division** currently has a Departmental transfer opportunity for a **DPS Sergeant in Las Vegas**. This position will supervise academy staff as well as cadets, to include writing evaluations and completing all first line supervisor requirements. This position is also responsible for assisting with In-service training and/or Academy training ensuring all training is held in accordance with Nevada POST regulations. There is no paid overtime associated with this position, any overtime will be accrued in compensatory time or flextime; all state holidays are paid days off. The workdays will be a 4 10's schedule, days off will be determined by the Lieutenant, however, when the Academy is in session the schedule will vary.

Due to the nature of business conducted within the DPS Training Division, the following experience is desired for the vacant position:
