

The **Investigation Division** currently has a Departmental transfer opportunity for a **DPS Sergeant in Fallon**. Due to the nature of business conducted within the Investigation Division, the current vacancy requires working experience assigned to an operational investigative unit with a primary focus in one or more of the following areas:

- *Illicit narcotics or pharmaceutical controlled substance investigations;*
- *Major crime investigations including, but not limited to: homicide; white collar crimes; sex crimes; crimes against children; and/or officer involved shootings;*
- *Homeland Security investigations and/or the collection, analysis, and dissemination of Homeland Security intelligence/information.*

**Special Conditions:**

- *Must be willing and capable of adjusting work hours to meet operational needs. This may include swing or graveyard shifts, weekends, and holidays.*
- *Will be expected to be on an on-call (PSTND) status for one week approximately every two to three months.*

This Sergeant position qualifies for DPS Sergeant salary, plus an accelerated rate of 5% for full-time investigations.
