4th of July Sobriety Check Point Results

On Saturday the 4th of July a Joining Forces sponsored sobriety check point was held in Douglas County on US 50 at Spooner Summit.

The event had 2,021 vehicles that passed through its check point that went from approximately 2:30 pm to 8:15 pm. There were 22 drivers that went to a secondary screening which found four people under the influence of a controlled substance and or alcohol. Three were arrested for driving under the influence of drugs and one for alcohol and one person was arrested on an outstanding warrant.

During the entire month of July law enforcement agencies all across the State Of Nevada will be increasing their numbers of officer and troopers on the roadways in a continued effort to curb driving under the influences of alcohol and or drugs. As a reminder motorists can be stopped and arrest for driving under the influence of prescribed medication if they advised to not operated heavy machinery or operate a vehicle. Certain prescribed medications have the same or similar effects on motorists as do illegal substances.
