Idaho Driver Dies in Single Vehicle Rollover

On Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at approximately 7:23 p.m. on State Route 318 in Nye County.

The preliminary investigation revealed that a grey 2008 Dodge Ram 3500 truck was traveling northbound on SR-318, south of mile marker 11 in Nye County.

The driver, 34 year old Jacob Mulberry from Kimberly, ID, was operating his vehicle at speeds exceeding the posted speed limit. Mulberry failed to drive within the marked travel lane the truck ran off the right side of the roadway and entered the east dirt shoulder. Mulberry over-corrected the steering to the left and the vehicle rotated counterclockwise across SR-318 and ran off the roadway to the left.

The vehicle veered back and forth before finally the left side tires furrowed in causing the vehicle to overturn. Mulberry was not wearing a seatbelt and he was ejected.

Mulberry succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced dead on scene by Nye County Deputy Coroner M. McKinnis. There were no other occupants.

This marks the Nevada Highway Patrol-Southern Command's 12th fatal collision for 2015.
