Passenger Ejected in Rollover on 4th of July

On Saturday, July 4, 2015 at approximately 7:10 p.m., Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a single vehicle rollover accident that occurred on six Mile Cove Road, Lake Mead.

The preliminary investigation revealed that a Nissan pickup was traveling eastbound on Six Mile Cove Road, a graded dirt road, in Clark County in the Lake Mead National Park. The driver lost control of the Nissan and steered right causing it to rotate clockwise. The Nissan rotated across the roadway into the south dirt shoulder and overturned into the desert area south of the roadway.

The 29 year old unrestrained right front passenger, who was identified as Ever Douglas Mejivar-Valle from Las Vegas, NV was ejected and pronounced deceased by Coroner T. Brown at 10:00pm on July 4, 2015.
