## Teenager Injured After Being Struck in Crosswalk in Carson City

On Tuesday, May 26, 2015 at approximately 3:08 p.m., Troopers from the Nevada Highway Patrol were dispatched to a vehicle versus pedestrian collision that occurred on South Carson Street just south of 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Carson City.

The preliminary crash investigation details indicate a silver 2003 Chevrolet Silverado pickup driven by 22 year old Logan Shane Olds of Carson City was traveling northbound on S. Carson Street. In the left lane approaching tow vehicle that had stopped for a pedestrian in the crosswalk. Mr. Olds switched lanes to the right lane to continue northbound when he struck a 13 year old female juvenile from Carson City who as crossing Carson St. in the marked crosswalk. Mr. Olds stopped immediately after the collision and has been cooperating with law enforcement with their investigation. The juvenile was taken by Care Flight to Renown with serious head injuries. She is still in serious condition at Renown.

Alcohol or drugs is not believed to be a contributing factor in the cause of this collision.

The right northbound lane of South Carson St. was shut down for approximately three hours while the NHP investigated the crash scene. The speed limit is 45 mph in this area of South Carson St.

Trooper Doug Hildebrand of the Nevada Highway Patrol's Multi-Disciplinary Investigation and Reconstruction Team (MIRT) is investigating this incident.
